We are a church made up of people from all walks of life. We love to see new people and that you will feel at home. Our Sunday mornings begin with a warm welcome and an invitation to join us in celebrating the good news about Jesus Christ.

Our Sunday services are a mixture of styles, with a weekly Early Church service and monthly Messy Church services aimed at families and children. Our 10.30am and 6pm zoom services are more traditional in style. We also have a Tuesday service for those unable to get to church on Sundays.
