Trinity Floral Memorial

As part of our outreach as a church to the local community in Leighton Buzzard we are creating a floral memorial to all who have lost their lives in Leighton Buzzard in the past year.

This memorial will consist of a large number of hand-crafted flowers and will be displayed on the Anteroom exterior wall on North street

The memorial will be completed for Easter Day and will then remain in position until late June or July when, Covid restrictions permitting, we will be holding a memorial service for all those who have lost a loved one across the town. This will be open to the whole community of Leighton Buzzard as an opportunity for all to come together to remember.

Leighton-Linslade Homeless Service (from Charles Horsefield)

Trinity has worked in partnership with Leighton Linslade Homeless Service since 2013 and would still be doing so were it not for the pandemic. At the start of the first lockdown, we had to suspend our Wednesday evening Drop-In and the Black Horse (leased by LLHS at considerable cost) had to become a residential hostel with just 7 guests permitted by the licensing authority, CBC. When in January all of those guests had received the support they needed and been successfully re-housed, the charity had lost most of its income but was still paying for staff and premises. A role could not be found for us within CBC's comprehensive, government-funded Housing Options scheme; there are no rough sleepers in the town and no reason why there should be any whilst the funding to CBC continues. So LLHS had to suspend its residential operation for the time being. But there are many households in the town who are struggling and the LL Community Food Bank will continue to operate out of the Black Horse until the owner finds a new tenant. We will be also be looking for other ways to help and there will be a need for more volunteers as restrictions are eased. Contrary to what you may have read, this is a success story to which Trinity has contributed and can continue to contribute. For further details contact; Charles Horsefield.
