## From The Manse

Palm Sunday, we are approaching the last Sunday of lent before Easter. Almost the end of the Journey following the footage of Jesus' ministry and it is a time for celebration of the coming of Jesus, his coming into Jerusalem. Large crowds gathered and shouted Hosanna and called him the King of Israel. It was a great welcome, and people were overwhelmed by great expectation. But soon after the expectation turned into disappointment, anger, and finally they shouted, "crucify him".

We are waiting for Easter as the end of the Lenten journey, and we are also waiting for the end of this long journey of pandemic, emptying our church building, meeting in different ways, different places. The times that we cannot greet each other properly, cannot touch, hug, or even shake hands.

We are waiting for the end of it but what we are expecting? Just going back to 'normal' as we were before the pandemic? We know that there are some changes, or a big change that we are facing. We have to see where we are honestly and practically.

I know it is difficult, difficult to think new things and accept the changes, as we saw it from the disciples of Jesus. They followed him for three years, all the way through his ministry, they heard his teaching, they saw what he had done, but their view had not been changed yet. However they still followed him, they still trusted him until they reached Golgotha, the place of death. All of their expectations, their dreams had died on the cross with Christ and they had a new beginning with the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Palm Sunday is not just the time of welcoming Him; it is the beginning of Holy week, the time of death and waiting for the resurrection, the new beginning and it is the time for us, time of recreation, the time of restart, time of resurrection by dying with him and having a new beginning through him. As the true Palm Sunday, we truly welcome him by following him to Golgotha and raised again on Easter morning.
