I could supply a range of green or blue base fabric (and probably scraps of other stuff!) for embroidery, appliqué or patchwork, if people did not have their own. It would be possible to do a patchwork square in shades of green and/or blue, or embroider words or favourite fish, butterflies, flowers.... the possibilities are pretty endless. I would then collate these into the piece of the size required and back and edge it.
