The Front Page: Singing about justice (from Connexion Magazine)

One of the most popular contemporary hymns in Singing the Faith is Martin Leckebusch's 'Show me how to stand for justice' (no. 713). His starting point is a verse from the book of the prophet Micah: "He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?" (Micah 6:8)

The website Singing the Faith Plus reminds us that each of the hymn's three verses echoes one of the 'requirements' of God. See www.methodist.org.uk/STF713

In verse 1 Martin declares that to 'stand for justice' is to reflect the 'immense compassion' of God in the lives we lead.

In verse 2 the focus is on kindness (in other Bible translations: 'mercy') as a response to our forgiveness and acceptance by Jesus, God's son.

Finally, in verse 3 (which has affinities with the Methodist Covenant Prayer), the requirement to "walk humbly with your God" is paraphrased as submitting "in humility... to the truth which I have heard".

Public Issues (from Charles Horsefield & 'Cilla Wagner)

As our thoughts and prayers are still focussed very much on Ukraine this week, Cilla would like to update you on aid being collected locally and delivered to those suffering the effects of the war.

People from Trinity have been supporting the charity Hope and Aid Direct for many years, by knitting squares and strips for blankets and donating old shop-bought blankets and throws. Their local coordinator Janet Page reports that they have, to date, sent 8 articulated lorries and 3 trucks full of donations to the Ukrainians. A further convoy will be leaving shortly and blankets and throws of all types remain the top priority.

Janet has also been able to pass on a few car-loads of donations to a military veterans charity for delivery to Poland. Donations from Trinity of hand-knitted items such as baby clothes, children's jumpers, hats, teddies and cot blankets - along with toiletries have also been passed on by Cilla and Phil via the military veterans in Leighton Buzzard. They would like to thank everyone who has contributed in any way to this effort.

Sadly there is no suggestion that the war will end any time soon but neither will the poverty that surrounds us here in Leighton Buzzard. Many of us make donations of food to the local food banks in the course of our visits to supermarkets but some find that they have surplus cans and dry goods at home that they would like to donate. Before the pandemic these might have been donated for use at the Wednesday evening Drop-In in the Chatteris suite by placing them in the marked bin in the corner of the ante-room. There is no Drop-In currently but the bin is still in use and any donations left there are taken to the food bank at the Black Horse.
