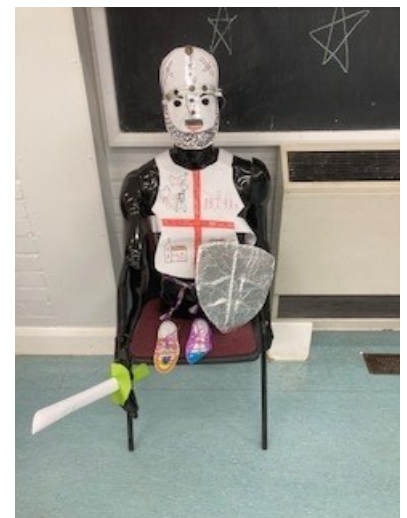

The Buzzer Buses are a lifeline to many in our town. They provide a door to door community transport service for anyone in the Leighton Buzzard, Linslade and surrounding villages who is unable to use regular public transport. There will be a retiring collection on their behalf after the 10.30am service on Sunday 17th November.

## Community Action Group News

Our efforts to engage with the wider community and to use Trinity's premises for public events bore some fruit on 21st October, when we hosted a Friends of the Earth (FoE) meeting attended by around 80 people, including the Mayor and several local councillors. A member of FoE's national committee and CBC's Champion for Biodiversity Net Gain (BNG) were the main speakers. As the initiative picks up pace, guidance will be produced and public bodies such as churches will be asked to have a BNG Policy. There will be opportunities for Trinity members to join in by helping the animals and insects (such as bees) that live in our gardens to survive and flourish. FoE have provided us with a lot of information leaflets about bees – could we do anything to support bees in the Trinity garden?

Another interesting national initiative is the Constituency Action Network, to which we are “signed up” as a church. The idea is to get local MPs engaged in the local issues that we think are important – not just as individuals but also as a congregation. The first issue that we are encouraged to pick up is poverty and the Lets End Poverty campaign have already written to the Prime Minister and they are now trying to secure a meeting with him. If anyone has written to their MP, as suggested in CAG News and Ideas Issue 2, please let me know.

We have been wondering about the possibility of providing an opportunity for coffee and chat on a Saturday morning – perhaps bi-weekly. If you would welcome the chance to meet and socialise on a Saturday and would be happy to support this initiative please contact Charles or come along to the next CAG meeting after 10.30 worship on 17<sup>th</sup> November.
