Christmas and the Foodbank

As usual at this time of year, Rosie at the LL Community Foodbank has indicated that they would be glad to see some Christmas food, like fancy biscuits and treats for children, in amongst the usual groceries we donate. Always remembering that the people who receive food bags often have very limited cooking facilities of course. The Foodbank often runs out of UHT milk and instant coffee at times of heavy demand.

In addition to bag distribution, on Christmas Day the Foodbank also send out boxes containing a hot Christmas lunch and tea, prepared on the day in the kitchen at The Sacred Heart. Churches are amongst the organisations invited to nominate people who will be on their own and if you want to do this please let me know.

Ending Poverty

As previously reported, whilst many of our existing and proposed activities here and overseas help to alleviate poverty, the Joint Public Issues Team (JPIT) tell us that government interventions will be needed if it is going to be ended. They want us to contact our MP, individually, as part of their Constituency Action Network and they will be sending out more details of this initiative soon. In the meantime it would be good to meet with the MP (Alex Mayer) to help her to understand about poverty in this area. Rosie has indicated that she would attend such a meeting, as would a representative of JPIT. And our neighbours at The Sacred Heart Justice and Peace Group have said that they like to join us. Perhaps we could organise a coffee morning in the New Year. Nobody would say that Leighton/Linslade is an area of urban deprivation but there are several parts of the town where people live in really miserable circumstances which often begin with family break-up. So what needs to be done and how can we help?

Circuit News

Circuit report to Church Council 22 October 2024

The following Circuit matters were noted by Roger Owers (Senior Circuit Steward) at the Church Council held 22 October 2024.

There are key vacancies at Circuit level. The Circuit urgently needs two new Circuit Stewards whose main role is to recruit and support the ministers. The Circuit is responsible for manses and someone is needed to be a first point of contact when there are problems in the manse and take on the organisation of the work to be done. In addition, Synod stewards are needed to represent the Circuit at the two District Synod meetings each year. (Speak to Roger if you feel you can help with any of these roles.)

Over the next few years there will be significant changes across the Circuit ministerial team. It has been agreed that Rev Margaret Newman will continue in the Circuit until August 2030. However Rev Nigel Bibbings has reduced his hours to ¾ full time equivalent, in preparation for retirement in August 2025 when he will be leaving the Circuit. There are no plans to replace him. It is also possible that Rev Joanne Sherwood will leave the Circuit in August 2026 at which point the Circuit will then only have four full time ministers. This in turn will mean that there are fewer ministers available on Sundays and a corresponding increase in the number of Local Arrangements. (*There are 3 LAs at Trinity in the next quarter—stewards be warned.*) Patrick's appointment as superintendent also comes to an end in August 2026 and the process to consider this position will start in Spring 2025.
