

## **Community Action Group**

Over the Christmas period some Trinity members supported the activities of the Community Foodbank. Our donations were added to the huge quantities coming in and volunteers filled dozens of bags for family workers from CBC and other agencies to deliver. On Christmas Day, meals were prepared in the kitchen of The Sacred Heart and delivered to people who were going to spend Christmas Day on their own.

JPIT report that the Constituency Action initiative, of which we are a part, sent 500 post cards about poverty to the Prime Minister in September. Our MP Alex Mayer has responded positively to an invitation to come to Trinity for an informal meeting about the nature and causes of poverty in Leighton Buzzard. But given her very busy schedule this may not happen for a while. When we meet her, JPIT want us to ask that the government "listen to the poor". We will be discussing how they might do that at our next Community Action Group meeting after the 10.30 service on 19 January.


