### Charity of the month—Action for Children

Action for Children <a href="www.actionforchildren.org.uk/">www.actionforchildren.org.uk/</a> is a UK children's charity created to help vulnerable children and young people and their families in the UK. The charity was started in 1869 by



Methodist Minister the Rev Dr Thomas Bowman Stephenson when he saw some children living rough under the arches of Waterloo Station. His work led to the creation of National Children's Home, now renamed Action for Children. Today they support 687,755 children, young people and their families in the UK every year.

Members at Trinity have supported the work of Action for Children for many years. If you have an AfC collection box or lantern, now would be a good time to hand it in to be emptied. Please pass your box to Chris Bosworth, who manages these boxes, or to a steward.

There will be a retiring collection for Action for Children after the 10.30am service on 16 February.
